



The single largest granite rock below Kadugannawa & the ocean is Bible Rock. Shaped like the famed 'Sigiriya' the rock, its surrounding forests still occupy many endemic fauna & flora.

The evening & mornings are very special up here, although the daytime needs to be spend inside the forest.

Of recent, there's a temple & monastery, occasionally occupied by monks from a temple below. A natural cave on top has a fresh water pool. We make camp on the Northern end of the rock, a splendid vantage point of the entire countryside.

**Total distance:** Around 25Km.

**Temperature:** Between 20 to 38 degrees.

**Conditions:** Rocky & slippery when wet.

**Elevation:** Between 800 to 2000 Feet.

**Difficulty level:** Moderately difficult on occasion.

**Time to get to the top:** About 3-4 easy hours

**Group size:** Minimum 2 - maximum 10

**Program:**

Day 1.

Arrive at the base of the mountain, sort out gear with porters & trek to the top via the East face. Stopping for lunch en-route, it's a moderately steep ascent until we take a break on the 'old testament rock' midway. Hereon the climbing gets progressively steeper, until you leave the forest & are upon a tall grass plain, which is the top. A very refreshing wind greets you evaporating your sweat & tiredness. We make camp on the North most ledge, one of the best small campsites! On prior arrangement, we meet-up with the priest at the site or at the monastery & have a communal dinner or a quite dinner at the campsite.

We use the monastery for washing & cleaning. Overnight in tents.

Day 2.

Wake-up to a splendid sunrise as everything below looks like little islands, with misty lakes. Breakfast at camp before we decamp & leave by the West face. The initial descent is a near vertical, which levels out. We have lunch en-route with the vehicle meeting us at the end of the trail.

You have the option of stopping at the riverside for a relaxing & refreshing swim.
